

After PM Modi's warning at SCO summit, Pak's Shehbaz Sharif slams use of terrorism for 'diplomatic point-scoring'



The International Press : Shortly after prime minister Narendra Modi's pointed message at the 23rd meeting of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation - at which he called out (but did not name) countries that 'use cross-border terrorism as an instrument... and give shelter to terrorists' - Pakistan's Shehbaz Sharif warned against the use of terrorism as a 'bat for diplomatic point-swearing'. Sharif also spoke about terrorism as a 'hydra-headed monster' to be fought with 'full conviction' irrespective of its source. The SCO was founded in 2001 in Shanghai by Russia, China, the Kyrgyz Republic, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan. India and Pakistan joined in 2017. The eight-member regional political and security bloc is seen as trying to counter Western influence in Eurasia. Sharif's remarks came after Modi labelled terrorism a 'threat to regional and global peace' and urged SCO leaders to not shy away from taking to task those countries that offer support of any kind. "Some countries use cross-border terrorism as an instrument of their policies and give shelter to terrorists. SCO should not hesitate to criticise such countries. SCO countries should condemn it. There should be no double standards on terrorism," he said. "We do not see the SCO as an extended neighbourhood, but rather as an extended family. Security, economic development, connectivity, unity, respect for sovereignty and territorial integrity, and environmental protection are the pillars of our vision for SCO," Modi added. Terrorism in all its forms and manifestations, including state terrorism, must be condemned in clear and unambiguous terms. There can be no justification for the killing of innocent people regardless of the cause or pretext," he said at a virtual meet hosted by India. Sharif called on the SCO to take "concerted and immediate actions... both in their national and collective capacity, to combat it". The Pakistani leader also declared that sacrifices made by his countrymen and women - in fighting against terrorism - were without parallel but acknowledged the evil continues to plague the region and is a "serious obstacle" to regional peace and stability.

The International Press : The Vice-president, Shri. Jagdeep Dhankar today highlighted that Uniform Civil Code will bind Bharat & its nationalism more effectively, and emphasized that "any further delay in implementation of UCC will be corrosive to our values." Addressing the 25th

convocation of IIT Guwahati today, the vice President stressed that Directive Principles of State Policy (DPSP) are 'fundamental in governance of the country' and it's the duty of the State to make them into rules. Mentioning that many DPSPs e.g. panchayats, cooperatives & Right to Education have already been translated into law, he underlined that it was time to implement Article 44 of the Constitution. Cautioning against the attempts to tarnish the image of India and "frequent orchestration of anti-national narratives," Shri Dhankar stressed, "It is high time choreographers of anti-Bharat narrative orchestration are effectively rebuffed."

The Vice-President also pointed out that "no foreign entity can be allowed to tweak with our sovereignty and reputation." Describing India as the oldest, largest, most functional & vibrant democracy that is giving stability to global peace & harmony, VP stressed, "We can not suffer dent on our flourishing and blossoming democracy and constitutional institutions." Noting that there is zero tolerance to corruption now,

he called for making a corruption free society. "Corruption is anti-democratic, corruption is poor governance, corruption runs down our growth... a corruption free society is the safest guarantee to your growth trajectory," he said. Shri Dhankar also expressed his disapproval of some people "taking to streets rather than taking recourse to lawful process" when they are held up for corruption. The Vice-President also asked the students to take pride in being Indians and its historical achievements. He also wanted them to be committed towards economic nationalism and refrain from making fiscal gains at the cost of the nation and nationalism. He also reminded students the valuable words of visionary personality Dr. B R Ambedkar - "You should be Indian first, Indian last and nothing else but Indians." In his convocation address, Shri Dhankar also invited the attention of the students towards the need of being tolerant. "We should also consider other point of view, as more often than not, other point of view is the correct point of view," he said. Earlier in the day, VP along with Smt (Dr.) Sudesh Dhankar visited and prayed at the renowned Maa Kamakhya temple in Guwahati. Later, he had an interaction with the students of IIT Guwahati. Governor of Assam, Shri Gulab Chand Kataria, the Chief Minister of Assam, Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma, Chairman Board of governors, IIT Guwahati, Dr. Rajeev Modi, Director IIT Guwahati, Prof. Parameswar K. Iyer, senior faculty members, students and other dignitaries were also present.

King Charles 'gets stressed' out in public when wife Camilla 'is not around'



The International Press : A body language expert pointed out what King Charles does gets "stressed" whenever his wife is not in his eyesight. Darren Stanton analyzed several royal family members over the years and shared some of the gestures they make. The expert said, "King Charles' key gestures are firstly to do with when he's not feeling confident, when he's a little unsure of himself or when he's looking for [Queen] Camilla (formerly known as Camilla Parker Bowles). He tends to get a little stressed when Camilla isn't in his eyeline because she gives him a lot of strength." Praising Camilla, the expert said that she is "clearly very confident, certainly in the last 5 or 6 years or so. Her key gesture is that she'll tend to put her hands behind her back when she's walking. This is an authoritative gesture. Unconsciously, this puts most of your vital organs at the front as if to expose them — psychologically, what you're saying here is 'I have enough confidence in who I am and what skills I have in order to allow myself to be more vulnerable.'" "You'll notice that Camilla has a very authoritative stance, especially when

she's talking to people. The [late] queen had this as well, except for Camilla it's more about authority, not so much power. She's basically establishing herself not only as Charles' wife but also as a senior member of the royal family in her own right. Also, we don't tend to see any smiles or gestures that aren't authentic. If she doesn't like somebody, she tends to show it," the body language expert said. Little key indicators are when he plays with his cufflinks or with the cuffs on his shirt and jacket. These are what's called pacifying gestures, which are things we do when trying to self-reassure ourselves. However, King Charles has evolved a bit over the years, he has become more confident in himself especially since becoming king so we tend to see these gestures less and less," the expert added. "The other key gesture Charles makes is a hand in the jacket. Growing up, both William and Harry inherited these gestures or picked them up unconsciously, especially William. Another key gesture that King Charles used to do is he would brush away imaginary dust on his jacket. To the outside world, he's just brushing something off of his jacket, but really it's another move to reassure himself when he's feeling nervous or uneasy," the expert explained.

The tourist-cum-cargo IWT terminal will be developed at a cost of ₹46.60 crores and is scheduled to be completed by February, 2024. Once developed, this terminal is likely to play a pivotal role in rejuvenating inland waterways transportation in the region for both cargo and passenger movement, paving the way for growth of trade & commerce.

improving the economies of scale for existing major trade like tea, polymer, coal, fertiliser etc. The modern terminal is also likely to play a crucial role as a harbinger of growth for the tourism sector with major destinations like Sibsagar, Majuli, Itanagar, Ziro Valley, Pasighat, Roing, Tawang valley etc. Under the Prime Minister's 'Act East Policy', MoPSW and IWAI has been making transformational changes in the Waterways sector in India over the last 9 years. 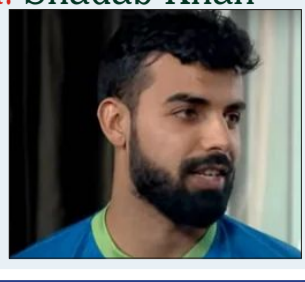

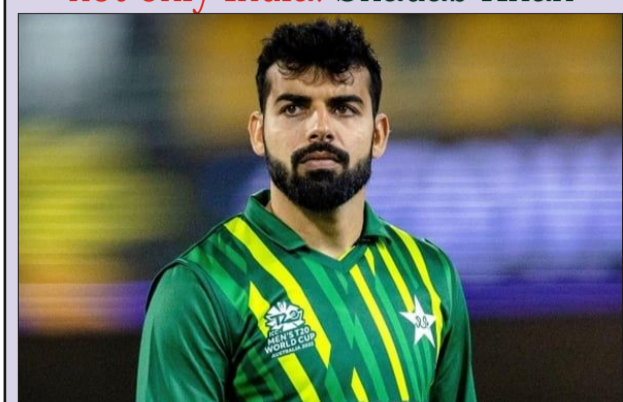

"They are coming from winning world titles, Spanish league titles.

They are not going to relax. They will compete because it is in their blood," he said. Martino takes over Miami with the club bottom of the Eastern Conference having lost their last seven games. They are ranked 27th out of the 29 clubs in MLS. The former Mexico and Atlanta United coach said there was still the chance to salvage something from this season, however. "One is to see if we can make the playoffs.

Right now that seems like a stretch, but as long as we have the possibility we can't stop trying," he said. "We are in a good place in the US Open Cup, and now there's a new tournament, Leagues Cup, that we will aim for. After that, the goal is to build for 2024," added the coach known as 'Tata'. Sporting Director Chris Henderson said the club would be making more changes to their squad in the coming weeks.

"Come late August we're going to have a different look. This will give the opportunity for Tata and his staff to work with the players in a new way. "It feels like a new beginning for the club and we're going to do everything we can to rise up the table game by game," he added. Martino won MLS Cup in 2018 with Atlanta United and said he was well aware of what awaited him in the North American league. "I see a league that is always evolving, a league that has a lot of rules, but they are very clear," he said. "It is very level for all the teams, the system of budgets and draft allows all teams at the start to have the same aspirations. "I like the complexity of the cold of one place, rain of another, heat of another. All that makes you as a coach have to think about more than just managing what happens on the field," he said. But Martino believes Messi will transform MLS. "That the world's greatest player decides to play in this league, evidently it will open an even greater scenario of growth," he said.

Maddison joins Tottenham, Arsenal sign Havertz



The International Press : English midfielder James Maddison has joined Tottenham Hotspur, while Arsenal have completed the signing of Kai Havertz, the clubs announced on Wednesday (28 June). Maddison completed his move to Spurs for a £40 million fee from Leicester City on a five-year contract which would keep him at the North London club till 2028. Spurs have been after the attacking midfielder since 2016. They missed out on him when he moved to Norwich in 2016 and again when the 26-year-old joined Leicester in 2018. On the other hand, the Gunners signed Kai Havertz from Chelsea for a record £67 million fee on a long-term deal. The German footballer became the

first signing for Arsenal this season. Havertz, who helped the Blues win the UEFA Champions League (UCL) trophy in 2021 by scoring the only goal in the final against Manchester City in Porto, is rated highly by Arsenal boss Mikel Arteta. "Kai is a player of top quality. He has great versatility and is an intelligent player. He will bring a huge amount of extra strength to our midfield and variety to our play," Arsenal's official website quoted Arteta. Meanwhile, Havertz stated that he is excited to join the Gunners and will be ready to give his "everything" for the club. "It's super exciting for me to join this amazing club and to be part of the Arsenal family. This club has such a big history, and I hope we

can achieve lots of things," the Arsenal website quoted him. Havertz added: "The mentality in the Arsenal squad is very high and you can feel that. That was one of the reasons it has been so hard to play against Arsenal recently. "The aim is to win trophies, and I'm going to give everything to do that for the supporters and everyone at the club. I'm now looking forward to meeting all the players and the staff when we come back for pre-season." After signing the German, it seems that the Gunners will not stop anytime soon. They are going all-in for West Ham United's captain Declan Rice as the club in under talks with the Conference League winners after submitting a bid of £100 million plus £5 million add-ons.

Smith gets his century but England fight back in second Test



The International Press : Steve Smith returned to form with a century for Australia, but England hit back to dismiss the tourists for 416 in the second Test at Lord's. Smith had flopped with scores of 16 and six during Australia's thrilling two-wicket win in the first Test at Edgbaston last week as the Ashes holders went 1-0 up in the five-match series. The 34-year-old put those low totals behind him with an innings of 110 -- the 32nd Test century of his brilliant career, his 12th in all Ashes contests and eighth in England. England, however, recovered well with the ball on Thursday by taking Australia's last five wickets for 77 runs. Veteran pacemen James Anderson and Stuart Broad, the two most successful quicks in Test

history, managed just two wickets between them. Instead, it was England's other two frontline pacemen who did the bulk of the damage, with Josh Tongue taking 3-98 in 22 overs on his Ashes debut and Ollie Robinson 3-100 in 24.4. England then survived a potentially tricky short stint with the bat to reach 13-0 at lunch. Australia, despite being sent into bat in overcast conditions and on a green-tinged pitch that favoured England's quicks, had resumed well-placed on 339-5. Smith was 85 not out, just 15 runs shy of his second Test century at Lord's following a superb 215 eight years ago at the 'Home of Cricket'. Australia's position would have been even stronger had Joe Root, the world's number one-ranked Test batsman, not taken two

wickets in four balls with his off-spin to remove Travis Head and Cameron Green. England's bowlers had failed to make the most of helpful conditions after captain Ben Stokes won the toss. And there were more worrying signs when Broad speared his first two balls down the legside, with left-hander Alex Carey glancing both deliveries for comfortable fours. But Broad, regaining his accuracy, had Carey lbw on review for 22 after rapping the wicketkeeper's back leg. Mitchell Starc got off the mark in style first ball when he clipped Broad past mid-on for four. But Anderson had Starc well caught by wicketkeeper Jonny Bairstow to leave Australia 358-7. Starc's exit brought in

Australia captain Pat Cummins, whose batting heroics had guided the tourists to victory in Birmingham. Smith went to 99 with a fortunate nick to third man for four off Anderson. Anderson then produced an excellent yorker which Smith just got the bat down on in time. But the very next ball saw Smith drive Anderson through the covers to complete a 169-ball century with his 14th four. Smith fell soon afterwards when a booming drive off Tongue was superbly caught by a diving Ben Duckett in the gully. Nathan Lyon fell into an obvious hooking trap before Robinson ended the innings when last man Josh Hazlewood was caught in the slips.
