

Trump's son Barron, 18, pulls out of political debut



The International Press : Donald Trump's youngest son Barron, 18, on Friday stepped back from his planned political debut, withdrawing as a delegate at the Republican Party convention in July. Barron, who has been largely shielded from the public eye, made global headlines this week when it appeared he would be the latest member of the Trump family to enter the political arena. But a statement from the office of his mother Melania Trump, the former president's third wife, soon put a stop to the convention plan. "While Barron is honored to have been chosen as a delegate by the Florida Republican Party, he regretfully declines to participate due to prior commitments," it said. The convention in Milwaukee will see Trump's

official crowning as the Republican challenger to Democratic President Joe Biden, with delegates from each state designating their candidate for the November election. Barron would have appeared alongside his siblings Donald Trump Jr., Eric Trump and Tiffany Trump as part of the Florida delegation. Barron lived in the White House as a child when his father was president, but has been fiercely protected from public view. Trump's oldest daughter, Ivanka, was a senior advisor in his first presidency alongside her husband Jared Kushner, while Don Jr. and Eric are regulars at Trump rallies and on the campaign trail. In March, the Republican National Committee elected Eric's wife Lara to a leadership position.



Putin reappoints Mishustin as Russia's PM

The International Press : Russian President Vladimir Putin proposed the reappointment on Friday of Prime Minister Mikhail Mishustin, a technocrat who has helped him through the war in Ukraine and the economic challenges wrought by Western sanctions over Moscow's invasion. The Duma's approval of the low-key Mishustin is nearly certain, as there is virtually no opposition in parliament, which has supported Putin in all his decisions, including the February 2022 invasion of Russia's smaller neighbour. As dictated by law, the government resigned just before Putin, Russia's paramount leader for nearly a quarter of a century, was sworn in for another six-year term on Tuesday after winning in a landslide re-election in March. There is no indication that Putin plans a big reshuffle of the government, which includes veteran Sergei Shoigu, in charge of Russia's defence since 2012, and Foreign

Minister Sergei Lavrov, in charge of Russia's diplomacy for two decades. Keeping his government intact would send a message of stability and of Putin's satisfaction with his team's progress at home and abroad, analysts say. "President Vladimir Vladimirovich Putin submitted to the State Duma a proposal on the candidacy of Mikhail Vladimirovich Mishustin for the post of Chairman of the Government," the speaker of the Duma, Vyacheslav Volodin, said on the Telegram messaging app. "Today, deputies will make a responsible decision on behalf of their constituents on this issue," Volodin said. **LOW-PROFILE BUREAUCRAT KEEPS ECONOMY AFLOAT** Mishustin, a career bureaucrat, was said to have no political ambitions before Putin tapped him as prime minister in 2020. With no background in the security services, he is not part of the so-called siloviki (strongmen) faction of intelligence veterans close to Putin. While keeping a low profile, however, Mishustin has been credited with keeping Russia's economy afloat after Kyiv's allies hit

the country with sanctions that have greatly complicated financing for Russian businesses and curtailed markets for the country's vast natural resources. Before becoming prime minister, Mishustin headed the federal tax service for a decade, where he was credited with more than doubling revenues. In October, with Russia facing increasing sanctions, Mishustin said Moscow would simplify procedures for citizens and companies from 25 "friendly" countries - including China, India, Brazil, Saudi Arabia, Turkey, Kazakhstan and Belarus - to invest in Russia. At a perilous moment for Putin in June last year, Mishustin said Russia must rally around the president as an abortive mutiny by mercenaries fighting in Ukraine had presented "a challenge to its stability". "For this, the consolidation of the whole of society is especially important. We need to act together, as one team, and maintain the unity of all forces, rallying around the president," Mishustin said. Mishustin, who will speak in the Duma before the vote, must answer how he will solve a number of tasks set by Putin for the government, including "economic and regional development, and increasing the defence capability of our country", Volodin said.

India completes troop exit from Maldives



The International Press : India has replaced some 80 soldiers on the Maldives with civilians after a demand by President Mohamed Muizzu who has pivoted the archipelago's ties towards China, New Delhi officials said yesterday. The Indian troops supported two helicopters and an aircraft that were given by New Delhi and mainly used for marine surveillance, search-and-rescue and medical evacuation operations on the islands of about half a million people. "Both sides have been working together to ensure continued operation of Indian aviation platforms," India's foreign ministry spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said. "Accordingly, deputation of competent Indian technical personnel has taken place." The announcement coincided with a visit by Maldivian Foreign Minister Moosa Zameer to India, the first visit by a senior official since Muizzu took office in November last year. Maldivian leaders traditionally made New Delhi their first port of call after coming to office but Muizzu has courted China instead and deepened defence ties as global powers jostle for influence in the Indo-Pacific region. At a meeting with Zameer, India's Foreign Minister Subrahmanyam Jaishankar said that

it was in both nations' common interest to understand how best to take ties forward. Zameer said afterwards on X that talks centred on cooperation in fields from infrastructure to capacity building. Apart from the troops issue, the Maldives' permission to dock at its port, in India's backyard, has also caused concern in New Delhi. India opened a new naval base near the Maldives in March to enhance surveillance in the Indian Ocean. But despite the strains, its development projects in the Maldives have in fact gained pace.

Campaigning for fourth phase of Lok Sabha Election in West Bengal has come to an end



The International Press : Campaigning for fourth phase of Lok Sabha Election in West Bengal has come to an end this evening. Elections will be held in six Parliamentary constituencies in the State on 13th of May 2024. The seats are Baharampur, Krishnanagar, Ranaghat, Bardhaman Purba, Bardhaman -Durgapur, Asansol, Bolpur and Birbhum. More than 1 crore 45 lakhs 30 thousands voters are eligible to cast their franchise in these six constituencies. In Baharampur total number of electorates are 17 lakhs 83 thousands 78, Krishnanagar total voters are 17 lakhs 55 thousands 631, Ranaghat total number of voters are 18 lakhs 71 thousands 658, Bardhaman Purba total number of electorates stands at 18 lakhs 1 thousands 333, Bardhaman - Durgapur total voters are 18 lakhs 51 thousands 780, Asansol is having total number of electorates 17 lakhs 70 thousands 281, Bolpur the voters number are 18 lakhs 39 thousands 234 while in Birbhum number of electorates are 18 lakhs 57 thousands 22. Out of total electorates 70 thousands 647 voters are above 85 years of age while electors aged between 18 to 19 years are 3 lakhs 23 thousands 544 in these six constituencies. Altogether 75 candidates are in the fray for six Parliamentary constituencies. 15 candidates are contesting from Baharampur, while 12 in Birbhum and 11 in Krishnanagar. 8 candidates each are in the fray from Bardhaman- Durgapur and Bolpur while 7 candidates each are fighting from Ranaghat, Bardhaman Purba and Asansol seats. In all 15 thousands 507 polling stations will be opened in six Parliamentary constituencies. Under this 791 polling stations will be manned by the women polling personnel while 42 polling stations have been identified as Model Polling Stations. Elaborate security arrangements have been made to ensure free and fair polling. Election Commission appointed observers are camping at their respective areas to keep a strong vigil on election process.

Kejriwal's big prediction on Maharashtra, Karnataka, Bengal election results

Kejriwal said."I have spoken to many experts over the phone in the last 20 hours I came out of jail. What everyone is saying is that BJP is not going to get majority," Kejriwal said adding that in Delhi BJP will lose all seven seats. The same fate awaits the BJP in Punjab, Kejriwal said. "On June 4, Modi will not come to power. INDIA will form the government and AAP will be part of it. Delhi will become a full state," Kejriwal said. Earlier in the day, Kejriwal said voting for the BJP for Narendra Modi will make Amit Shah the prime minister as Narendra Modi will retire next year after turning 75. The statement created a political flashpoint with the BJP asserting that Narendra Modi would remain the prime minister and accusing Kejriwal of creating confusion. More than 200 dead in Afghanistan flash floods: UN



The International Press : Flash floods that have ripped through northern Afghanistan left more than 200 people dead in a single province, the United Nations said on Saturday. More than 200 people were killed and thousands of houses were destroyed or damaged in Baghlan province when heavy rains on Friday sparked massive flooding, the UN's International Organization for Migration told AFP. In Baghlani Jadid district alone, up to 1,500 homes were damaged or destroyed and "more than 100 people died", an IOM

emergency response lead said, citing figures from the Afghanistan National Disaster Management Authority. Taliban government officials said 62 people had died as of Friday night. Spokesman Zabihullah Mujahid said "hundreds of our fellow citizens have succumbed to these calamitous floods" in a statement on X, formerly Twitter, on Saturday, without differentiating the numbers of dead and injured, though he told AFP dozens had been

killed. Multiple provinces across Afghanistan saw flash flooding, with officials in northern Takhar province reporting 20 dead on Saturday. Rains on Friday also caused heavy damage in northeastern Badakhshan province, central Ghor province and western Herat, officials said. Emergency personnel have been deployed to the affected areas and were rushing to rescue injured and stranded people, the defence ministry said. Afghanistan -- which had a relatively dry winter, making it more difficult for the soil to absorb rainfall - is highly vulnerable to climate change. The nation, ravaged by four decades of war, is one of the poorest in the world and, according to scientists, one of the worst prepared to face the consequences of global warming.

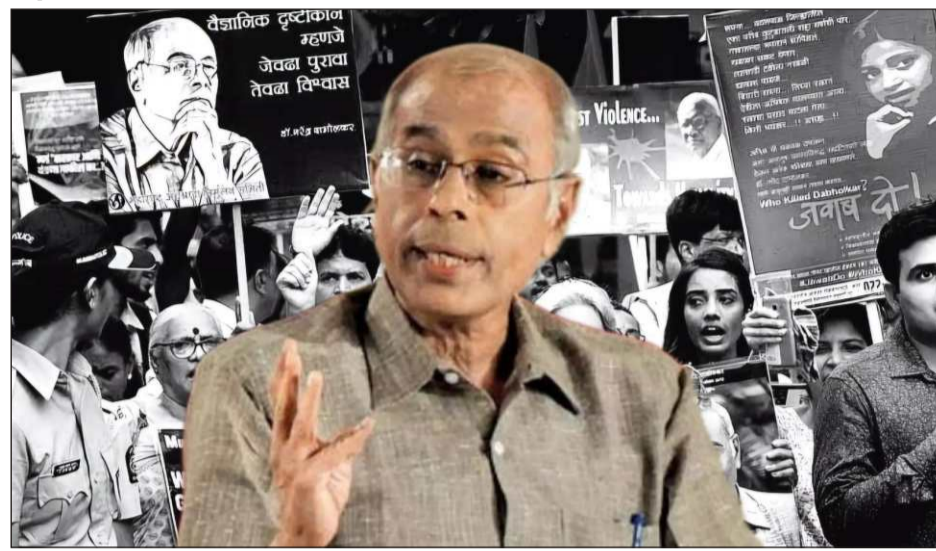

The Bharat Pavilion at Cannes serves as a platform for the Indian film community to engage in various activities, including, fostering production collaborations, curated knowledge sessions, signing distribution deals, greenlighting scripts, B2B meetings and networking with prominent entertainment and media players from around the world. The Pavilion will be organized by the National Film Development Corporation (NFDC) in collaboration with the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce & Industry (FICCI) as industry partner. A 'Bharat Stall' will be put in the Marche du Cannes through the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) for providing the industry to connect & collaborate. The Bharat Pavilion has been designed by the National Institute of Design, Ahmedabad is christened on 'The Sutradhara' for depicting this year's theme of "Create in India". As we look at India's presence, this year, at the Cannes Film Festival, a rich history and the landscape of creativity denote the direction on an international stage. In the spotlight, Payal Kapadia's magnum opus, "All We Imagine As Light," poised to captivate audiences and vie for the prestigious Palme d'Or. Special Court for UAPA cases, Pune, sentences two accused to life imprisonment with fine of Rs. 5 lakh each in Dr. Narendra Dabholkar murder case



The International Press : The Ld. Court of District Judge-9 and Addl. Sessions Judge, Special Court for UAPA cases, Pune today convicted Sachin Prakashrao & Sharad Bhausaheb Kalaskar in Dr. Narendra Dabholkar Murder Case and sentenced them to undergo life imprisonment with a fine of Rs. 5 lakh each. The Learned Court held them guilty of murder of Dr. Narendra Dabholkar. CBI had registered the instant case in pursuance of the orders dated 09.05.2014 of the Hon'ble Bombay High Court taking over investigation of the case earlier registered at PS Deccan, Pune City on allegations that Dr. Narendra Dabholkar, was shot dead by two assailants in the morning in August 2013 at Omkareshwar Bridge, Pune when he was on morning walk. After investigation, CBI filed charge-sheet in Pune Court on 06.09.2016. Subsequently, Supplementary Charge-sheets were filed by CBI on 13.02.2019 and 20.11.2019.

The trial of the case was conducted in the Court of Hon'ble District & Addl. Session Judge, Pune, Special Court for UAPA against the accused Sachin Prakashrao Andure, Sharad Bhausaheb Kalaskar, Virendrasinh Tawde, Vikram Vinay Bhavne and Sanjiv Punalekar. After completion of trial,

Mbappe and PSG aim to seize moment in Champions League semifinal



The International Press : Paris Saint-Germain are bidding to overturn a 1-0 first-leg deficit and beat Borussia Dortmund in their Champions League semi-final return match on Tuesday, with the aim of bringing the curtain down on the Kylian Mbappe era at the club in the final at Wembley. The only time PSG have previously appeared in the biggest match in club football turned out to be a depressingly flat occasion, with the French side losing 1-0 to Bayern Munich behind closed doors in Lisbon in 2020, at the height of the pandemic. Reaching the June 1 showpiece in London, and playing before a crowd of 90,000 against either Real Madrid or Bayern again, would be a different occasion entirely.

Getting there would give Mbappe the chance to end his seven-year stay with the Qatar-owned outfit in the best possible way, as they look to win the Champions League for the first time in their history, and just the second time for a French club after Marseille in 1993. Mbappe informed PSG in February of his intention to depart the Parc des Princes when his contract expires at the end of the season, ending a prolific association with his hometown team which began when he signed from Monaco in 2017. Now 25 and the captain of France, Mbappe has become the Parisians' all-time top scorer with 255 goals in 305 appearances so far, including 43 this season alone. He has 48 in the Champions League -- a tally which

includes six with Monaco in his breakthrough 2016/17 campaign -- and Tuesday's second leg against Dortmund would be the ideal time for him to bring up the half-century. Luis Enrique's team did not produce their best performance in losing 1-0 in Germany last week, and the pressure is on them as favourites to turn the tie around at home. However, a repeat of what happened when they hosted Dortmund in the group stage last September will suffice -- on that occasion they won 2-0, with Mbappe netting the first goal from the penalty spot. "We are sure we are going to turn it around and qualify for the final," Mbappe told several media including AFP on Sunday on the sidelines of an event on the French capital's famed Champs-

Elysees. "There is a lot of pressure on us, which is normal because there is a place in the Champions League final at stake. "All the more so when you know about this club's past in the competition." **Defensive dilemma** PSG were not necessarily expected to get as far as the semi-finals this season, with the squad undergoing a major overhaul following the departures of Lionel Messi and Neymar at the end of the last campaign. They had gone out in the last 16 in five of the last seven seasons, frequently failing in spectacular fashion in that time. Before this season, and since the Qatari takeover of the club in 2011, PSG had won nine Champions League knockout ties in total.

Five of those came behind closed doors in the Covid era, including two ties played as one-off games on neutral turf in Lisbon in 2020. This season's draw has been as kind as it could be, with Real Sociedad ideal opponents in the last 16 and Dortmund the best they could have wished for in the semi-finals. However, their performance in overturning a first-leg deficit to defeat Barcelona in the last eight is not to be dismissed. While all eyes will, as usual, be on Mbappe, the key to PSG's chances of recovering from another first-leg loss when they face Dortmund may be in defence. They suffered a huge blow when Lucas Hernandez ruptured the anterior cruciate ligament in his left knee while trying to stop Niclas Füllkrug's goal in Dortmund. He is set to be out for many months. In addition, left-back Nuno Mendes, who has himself not long returned from a lengthy spell out, had a torrid time up against Jadon Sancho at the Signal Iduna Park. Mendes will still almost certainly start at the Parc des Princes, while Danilo Pereira looks the most likely option to partner skipper Marquinhos at centre-back. "We know how strong we are at the Parc. Nothing is finished, everything is open," Marquinhos said after the first leg. One other factor in favour of PSG, who have already wrapped up the French title, might be freshness -- their weekend league game at Nice was postponed to help them prepare.

Jadeja proves all-round value ahead of T20 World Cup



The International Press : India will be counting on Ravindra Jadeja's all-round brilliance in the T20 World Cup in June and the Chennai Super Kings player looks in fine fettle as he produced a match-winning performance in Sunday's Indian Premier League match against Punjab Kings. The 35-year-old is India's premier spin-bowling all-rounder, apart from being a gun fielder, and will be expected to play a key role in the T20 showpiece in the United States and West Indies, where the ball is likely to turn. Against Punjab in Dharamsala, Jadeja topscored for Chennai with a breezy 43 and then returned to claim 3-20 to help the defending champions climb to third place after their sixth win in 11 matches. "It was a day game, so the wicket was slow," man of the match Jadeja said of his batting approach in a low-scoring contest. "We did well in the (batting) powerplay, but then we couldn't build

partnerships. We wanted to build partnerships, so in the last four-five overs, we could score quickly." With the ball, Jadeja dismissed Punjab's topscorer Prabhsimran Singh, skipper Sam Curran and Ashutosh Sharma as Chennai, having posted 167-9, restricted Punjab to 139-9. It was the seventh time Jadeja bowled his full quota of four overs this season and Chennai have won five of those matches. "During the powerplay, the wicket always looks flat but as the ball gets a little old, the ball doesn't come on to the bat," the left-arm spinner said of his bowling. "We felt we were 15-20 runs short but we bowled well in the powerplay and middle overs, didn't bowl loose balls." Kolkata Knight Riders beat Lucknow Super Giants on Sunday to top the points table though Rajasthan Royals, behind only on net run-rate, have played one match fewer.

Friends forever: Rohit through the lens of Yuvraj

When asked about Rohit's significance in the upcoming tournament, Yuvraj expressed his unequivocal support for the Hitman to continue leading the side. "(Rohit's presence is going to be) very crucial. I think we need a really good captain, a sensible captain who takes decisions well under pressure. And he's the one to take them," T20 World Cup 2024 ambassador Yuvraj said. "He was the captain when we lost in the (Cricket World Cup) 50-over final (in 2023). He has won five IPL trophies as a captain. I think we need somebody like him to captain India." The bond between Yuvraj and Rohit traces back to the Mumbaikar's early days in the Indian setup. It's widely known that Yuvraj was one of Rohit's close friends within the team. In fact, Yuvraj was part of the squad when Rohit made his debut for India. It was during the fall of Yuvraj's wicket that the young Hitman stepped onto the international cricket scene to bat, making his first appearance against Ireland back in 2007. Their connection came full circle in 2019 when Yuvraj's final season as an active cricketer came under Rohit's captaincy at the Mumbai Indians in the Indian Premier League. Following that tournament, Yuvraj announced his retirement from all forms of cricket in June 2019. Speaking from a personal perspective, Yuvraj recalled his initial impression of Rohit, who joined the Indian team at the tender age of 17 and showered praise on the Indian captain, emphasising his humility, camaraderie and leadership qualities both on and off the field. "Very poor English," Yuvraj said jokingly. "Very funny guy. From the streets of Borivli (in Mumbai), we always tease him. But a great guy at heart." "The more success he's had, he has never changed as a person. That's the beauty of Rohit Sharma. Fun-loving, always having fun with the guys, a great leader on the park and one of my closest friends from cricket. "I really want to see Rohit Sharma with a World Cup trophy and a World Cup medal. He really deserves it." Uganda name squad for historic T20 World Cup appearance



The International Press : Brian Masaba holds the honour of leading Uganda in their first appearance at the ICC Men's T20 World Cup, with their 15-player squad locked in. After stunning Zimbabwe and the African field in qualifying, the Cricket Cranes look ahead to Group C play, taking on co-hosts West Indies, New Zealand, Papua New Guinea and Afghanistan. Masaba will be deputised by Riazat Ali Shah, and the skipper joins several Ugandans with over a decade's experience in international cricket, underlined by 43-year-old Frank Nsubuga, who will be one of the oldest players in the tournament. A cult hero in emerging cricket circles, Nsubuga's squad selection caps off a life's devotion to the game. He first represented Uganda in ICC events as a 17-year-old in the 1997 ICC Trophy, a pathway event

on the road to Cricket World Cup 1999. Fast-forward 25 years, Nsubuga made headlines, taking a sprawling catch approaching the boundary in a Cricket World Cup Challenge League match against Kenya in 2022. He's not the only Ugandan player to turn heads in recent times, with spin-bowling all-rounder Alpesh Ramjani ready to continue in the same form that led to his nomination for 2023 ICC Men's T20I cricketer of the Year. One of several notable all-rounders in the squad, Ramjani claimed the most T20I wickets in men's cricket last year, 55 of them at an economy of under five an over. Fellow left-arm orthodox spinner and squad member Henry Ssenyondo also comes off a strong 2023, taking 49 wickets in the same period. Riazat Ali Shah and Dinesh Nakrani are two notable aggressors with

the bat, and the side also boasts U19 World Cup experience through youngster Juma Miyaji, who played in the 2022 event in the West Indies. While it is the first time Uganda will take part in a senior men's World Cup of any type, Uganda have been represented in a global event through the now-defunct East Africa team that took part in the 1975 Cricket World Cup. Samuel Walusimbi was the sole Ugandan player in the squad, featuring in three matches. Uganda begin their T20 World Cup campaign on June 3 against Afghanistan in Guyana. Man Utd rut 'not good enough' but Ten Hag vows to fight on



The International Press : Erik ten Hag took responsibility for Manchester United's miserable showing in a 4-0 thrashing by Crystal Palace on Monday, but said he is still the right man to turn the club's fortunes around. Palace completed a first ever league double over United in style as Michael Olise scored twice, while Jean-Philippe Mateta and Tyrick Mitchell were also on target for the in-form Eagles. Defeat left Ten Hag's men eighth and at risk of both their worst ever Premier League finish and missing out on European competition next season. The Dutchman's future is in doubt with structural change ongoing at Old Trafford since British billionaire Jim Ratcliffe bought a minority stake and took sporting control of the club earlier this year. "It's clear and it's obvious this is under-performing,"

said Ten Hag. "We didn't act how we want to do it and this is by far not good enough." Ten Hag's options were again limited by a mounting injury list. Captain Bruno Fernandes missed a club game through injury for the first time in his career, while England international duo Marcus Rashford and Harry Maguire were also absent. The makeshift centre-back pairing of Casemiro and Jonny Evans were torn apart by Palace's pace and invention. "Absolutely," added Ten Hag on whether believes he is the right man to lead United forward. "If we have the right players available we have a good squad but we miss almost the whole back-line and then we have problems. "I will keep fighting and I prepared the team in the best way I could do. It was

not good enough, by far not good enough, so I have to take the responsibility for that but I will find the energy and I will prepare them for Sunday." Worse could be to come for Ten Hag when title-chasing Arsenal visit Old Trafford at the weekend. United have never failed to finish in the top seven in the Premier League era and must do so or beat Manchester City in the FA Cup final to qualify for Europe. But the embarrassing scoreline at Selhurst Park is not unprecedented during Ten Hag's reign. United lost 4-0 at Brentford, 7-0 to Liverpool and 6-3 away to Manchester City during his first season in charge. This season they have conceded 81 goals in all competitions, the club's worst tally since 1976-77. After a disappointing early exits from both the

Champions League and League Cup, a FA Cup run has offered Ten Hag some relief. But they booked their place in a second consecutive final only by surviving a penalty shootout against second-tier Coventry after blowing a 3-0 lead to draw 3-3. "That was tough to watch," said former United midfielder Paul Scholes of the Red Devils' display at Palace. "That could have been 7-0." Ratcliffe's INEOS group have already begun making appointments they hope will turn around a decade of decline at the 20-time English champions. Jason Wilcox has been named the club's new technical director, while Newcastle's Dan Ashworth has been targeted as sporting director and former Manchester City executive Omar Berrada will take over as CEO.
