

Kejriwal granted bail by India's top court to campaign for election



The International Press : India's top court has granted interim bail to Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal, more than a month after he was arrested in a corruption case, reports BBC.

According to his lawyer, there is no restriction on his election campaigning in the ongoing Lok Sabha 2024 polls.

The court said that the bail is applicable until 1 June after which he must surrender to authorities again.

A former anti-corruption crusader, Mr Kejriwal was arrested in connection with a now-scrapped alcohol sales policy in March.

He has denied the charges against him and has called his arrest "illegal".

The chief minister moved the Supreme Court after the Delhi High Court refused to give him bail last month. His bail was strongly opposed in court by India's financial crimes agency, the Enforcement Directorate.

On Friday, a bench of Justice Sanjiv Khanna and Justice Dipankar Datta said Mr Kejriwal would have to surrender on June 2, two days before the results of India's general election are due.

The court has said Mr Kejriwal would be allowed to campaign for the election upon his release but will not be allowed to perform official duties during that time.

A member of the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP), Mr Kejriwal was arrested on March 21, days after the election dates were announced. He was the third AAP leader to be jailed in the case.

The ED accused him of favouring liquor barons in exchange for kickbacks. The party has denied the allegation.

Critics said the action against Mr Kejriwal and several other opposition parties was politically motivated and denied them a level playing field in the parliamentary election. The Indian

government said the investigative agencies were just doing their work.

During his time in jail, Mr Kejriwal did not give up office. His party said he was running the Delhi government from prison. A diabetic, the Delhi chief minister's detention also caused concerns about his health among supporters.

Last month, Mr Kejriwal and his party accused prison authorities of refusing to give him proper treatment which, they said, had led to the spike in his blood glucose levels.

The ED, however, claimed he had deliberately had too many mangoes and sweets to spike his sugar levels and use it as grounds for bail.

He later received insulin shots after a court ordered doctors from a premier hospital to determine his medication.

During the court proceedings, the ED opposed Mr Kejriwal's bail plea, claiming it would set a bad precedent as he had evaded the agency's summons nine times.

Justice Khanna, however, said: "While granting interim bail, we examine whether there will be any misuse or if the person is a hardened criminal. That is not the case here." In March, the arrest had also drawn comments from the US and Germany.

US State Department spokesperson, Mathew Miller said the country was closely following Mr Kejriwal's arrest and actions taken against opposition parties in India.

"We encourage fair, transparent, timely legal processes [in both cases]," Mr Miller said. The German foreign ministry said it hoped that Mr Kejriwal would get a "fair and impartial trial as India is a democratic nation".

India summoned senior diplomats of both the US and Germany to register its protest.



Modi won't become prime minister of India: Rahul Gandhi

The International Press : Congress leader Rahul Gandhi said on Friday (May 10) asserted that Narendra Modi will not make it to the post of prime minister this time as an INDIA bloc storm is arriving in Uttar Pradesh, reports PTI from Kannauj in Uttar Pradesh.

"You take it as a written guarantee that Narendra Modi is not going to become the prime minister of India. It's over," he said at a rally in Kannauj, from where Samajwadi Party president Akhilesh Yadav is contesting the Lok Sabha polls. "Aap likh ke le lo (take it in writing)," he said at the rally predicting that the BJP was set to lose the election. Apart from Gandhi and Yadav, Aam Aadmi Party leader Sanjay Singh addressed the joint INDIA

bloc rally. In Uttar Pradesh, the Congress is fighting on 17 of the 80 Lok Sabha seats. Last time, the BJP won 62 seats, and two went to its ally Apna Dal (S). The INDIA block has done the needed poll preparations over the past years, Gandhi said.

He countered Modi again on his recent allegation that there was a nexus between the Congress and business tycoons Adani and Ambani. "You have seen that in 10 years, Narendra Modi ji had not taken the names of Adani and Ambani," the former Congress president said. But now he is talking the names of people who he thinks can save him, he said.

"The INDIA bloc has surrounded me, I am losing. Save me, Adani-Ambani ji save me," Gandhi mocked, suggesting that the two industrialists were Modi's "friends". Citing a news report about vehicles being stopped from

reaching the rally venue, Gandhi said this would not prevent Akhilesh Yadav from winning in Kannauj. "And in Uttar Pradesh, you will see, I am giving it to you in writing that the storm of the INDIA bloc is arriving. You take it in writing. The biggest defeat of the BJP is going to take place in Uttar Pradesh," he said.

He said this was because people had made up their mind that change is going to happen in UP. "A change is going to happen in India. People have made up their mind," Gandhi added.

In his address, SP chief Akhilesh Yadav said that the BJP has scored low in the general election phases so far. He said Kannauj was taken to the "heights of development" by the earlier SP government in Uttar Pradesh. "People who travel the highway know that the highway was built by the 'Samajwadis'," he said.

"We assure the people of Kannauj that we will work to enhance the fragrance of development which has got stalled," he said, alluding to the region's perfume trade. Kannauj goes to the polls on May 13.

Joe Biden wants to remind 2024 voters of a record



The International Press : US President Joe Biden is running for reelection on a record and an agenda -- often Donald Trump's.

In a hotel ballroom in Seattle, at fancy homes in California and at stops in Illinois and Wisconsin over the past week, Biden has been betting that reminding voters about Trump's presidency and highlighting his Republican opponent's latest campaign statements will work to the Democrat's advantage.

At a Seattle fundraiser Friday night, Biden brought up Trump's recent interview with Time magazine in which Trump said states should be left to determine whether to prosecute women for abortions or to monitor their pregnancies. "I really urge you to read it," Biden said.

Biden, who had another Seattle fundraiser scheduled for Saturday before returning to the East Coast, has plenty of other Trump material to draw from, too.

The president highlights how Trump has promised, if elected, to be "a dictator on Day 1", how he has suggested the United States would not necessarily defend allies from aggression and how he has pledged to "totally obliterate the deep state" in the federal bureaucracy, which he blames for blocking his first-term agenda.

"And he said a whole lot more," Biden said during a Chicago appearance. "But the bad news is he means what he says. Unless you think I'm kidding, just think back to the 6th of January. This guy means what he says," referring to the riot at the U.S. Capitol on Jan. 6, 2021.

Biden wants the 2024 election to be a referendum on Trump's record and plans, but he also wants voters to look favorably on his own policies and actions. Biden and his allies think the country needs reminding about Trump's tenure and his outlandish and often concerning statements,

particularly because the Republican is no longer ubiquitous on X, formerly Twitter, nor is he in front of television cameras as often as he once was.

"Chaos is nothing new for Trump," Biden said in Chicago. "His presidency was chaos. Trump is trying to make the -- the country forget about the dark and unsettling things that he did when he was president. Well, we're going to not let them forget."

Biden frequently highlights Trump's efforts to overturn the results of the 2020 election and how he stood by when supporters violently stormed the Capitol as Congress met to certify his loss to Biden. He also points to Trump separating children from their families at the U.S.-Mexico border, tax cuts the Republican pushed through that benefited corporations and the wealthy and his repeated efforts to overturn the Affordable Care Act.

Trump's son Barron, 18, pulls out of political debut



The International Press : Donald Trump's youngest son Barron, 18, on Friday (10 May) stepped back from his planned political debut, withdrawing as a delegate at the Republican Party convention in July.

Barron, who has been largely shielded from the public eye, made global headlines this week when it appeared he would be the latest member of the Trump family to enter the political arena.

But a statement from the office of his mother Melania Trump, the former president's third wife, soon put a stop to the convention plan.

While Barron is honored to have been chosen as a delegate by the Florida Republican Party, he regrettably declines to participate due to prior commitments, it said.

The convention in Milwaukee will see Trump's official crowning as the Republican challenger to Democratic President Joe Biden, with delegates from each state designating their candidate for the November election.

Barron would have appeared alongside his siblings Donald Trump Jr., Eric Trump and Tiffany Trump as part of the Florida delegation. Barron lived in the White House as a child when his father was president, but has been fiercely protected from public view.

Trump's oldest daughter, Ivanka, was a senior advisor in his first presidency alongside her husband Jared Kushner, while Don Jr. and Eric are regulars at Trump rallies and on the campaign trail.

In March, the Republican National Committee elected Eric's wife Lara to a leadership position.

Religious fanaticism is still a glaring threat for peace in South Asia

Why do religious militants think their actions are right or righteous? What keeps me from acting like them? Why do some religious persons act on their beliefs in charitable, inspiring and deeply humane ways? Is secularism the solution to religious violence, or is it part of the problem? This Element explores the vexed issue of violence done in the name of God, looking at the topic through the lens of peace and conflict studies, religious studies and historical studies. The beliefs of various communities, religious and secular, are explored, looking at how convictions inhibit and enable violence. This Element aims to foster a deeper and more nuanced understanding of the promises and perils of religion so that readers can better respond to a world filled with violence. Religious fundamentalism is meticulous adherence to the strict interpretation of religion, while religious extremism goes further by including violent action to ensure this adherence. Following this analysis, the chapter provides a brief account of extremist actions taken in the name of Judaism, Christianity, Islam, Buddhism and Hinduism. It then discusses the balance between countering religious extremism and ensuring human rights. Religious extremism is not a new phenomenon in South Asia but it has certainly grown during the 21st century and that too across the region. While there are historical reasons behind religious divisions and fissures in South Asia (e.g., the two-nation theory with reference to the creation of a separate homeland for the Muslims of the Indian subcontinent), religious nationalism is a key driver behind the securitization of religious minorities. Although the existence of

Muslim extremists is linked to how religion was used as a tool to recruit and mobilize mujahedeen against the Soviet occupation of Afghanistan between 1979 and 1988, the global dynamics after the September 11, 2001, terrorist attacks and the "war on terror" have also influenced religious radicalization and extremism in Pakistan. In contrast, Buddhist and Hindu nationalism have been key drivers of religiously motivated extremism targeting religious minorities, especially Muslims, in Sri Lanka and India. There are similarities in terms of how Buddhist, Hindu, and Muslim extremist groups have been propagating hate and inciting violence; for instance, many extremist groups now increasingly use social media. As this article argues, the presence of religious extremism in South Asia presents a significant challenge to peace and security. This includes various forms of extremism targeting different religious groups and promoting anti-Western sentiments. International terrorist organizations are active in the region, while Hindu and Buddhist nationalists contribute to the marginalization and violence against Muslims. Creating an environment of tolerance, inclusivity, and respect for all religious communities is crucial to address these complex issues effectively.



Save India from dictatorship

The International Press : A top opponent of Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi yesterday urged his compatriots to resist "dictatorship", after the country's top court provisionally released him from jail to campaign in national elections. Arvind Kejriwal, chief minister of the capital Delhi and a key leader in an opposition

alliance formed to compete against Modi in the polls, was granted bail on Friday after weeks in custody. In a defiant press conference the day after his release, Kejriwal said the outcome of the election would determine whether India remained a democracy. "I have come to beg 1.4 billion people to save my

country," he said. "Save my country from this dictatorship." Kejriwal also personally accused the prime minister of targeting his opponents with criminal probes. "Modi has started a very dangerous mission," he said. "Modi will send all opposition leaders to jail." Kejriwal's government was

accused of corruption when it liberalised the sale of liquor in 2021 and gave up a lucrative government stake in the sector. The policy was withdrawn the following year, but the resulting probe into the alleged corrupt allocation of licences has since led to the jailing of two top Kejriwal allies.

India fully withdraws soldiers from Maldives



The International Press : In the midst of a diplomatic row, India has withdrawn all its soldiers from Maldives, the island country's government said in an official statement. Indian troops were withdrawn from Maldivian territory shortly before the May 10 deadline set by the latter's president, Mohamed Muizzu earlier, reports The Hindustan Times. President Muizzu, widely seen as a pro-China leader, had set May 10 as the deadline for the withdrawal of the Indian military personnel from his country. The withdrawal of Indian military personnel was one of the key promises of Muizzu's government during his presidential campaign last year. Heena Waleed, president's office's chief spokesperson, confirmed to the media that the last of the Indian soldiers stationed in Maldives had been repatriated, without giving an exact number of troops. She added details about the number of the soldiers stationed would be disclosed later. Maldives had earlier said in a government statement that 51 out of the total number of Indian troops stationed in the country were repatriated to India on Monday. The government earlier announced the presence of

89 Indian soldiers in the Maldives, citing official documents. After Muizzu set the May 10 deadline, India agreed to withdraw its troops from the country before the last date to avoid any conflicts. At a media briefing in New Delhi on Thursday, External Affairs Ministry spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said the first and the second batches of the Indian personnel returned to India and "now deputation of competent Indian technical personnel has taken place" to operate the three Indian aviation platforms. This development comes just a day after India's External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar met with his Maldivian counterpart Moosa Zameer. The two leaders had extensive talks on bilateral ties and regional security issues of India and Maldives. Zameer said that the two foreign ministers also discussed the possibility of President Muizzu making a visit to New Delhi very soon. The Maldives is India's key maritime neighbour in the Indian Ocean Region and occupies a special place in its initiatives like 'SAGAR' (Security and Growth for All in the Region) and the 'Neighbourhood First Policy' of the Modi government.

BJP leader Deveraje Gowda taken into police custody in Karnataka sex scandal



The International Press : BJP leader Deveraje Gowda was taken into police custody on Friday night near Hiriyur in the Chitradurga district after allegations of molestation and sexual harassment were levelled against him. Notably, Gowda, who recently grabbed headlines over links with the alleged obscene video case involving Hassan MP Prajwal Revanna, had flagged the matter to central BJP leadership in December 2023 before the party joined hands

with Janata Dal (Secular). The Special Investigation Team (SIT), probing the Prajwal Revanna sex scandal case, had directed Gowda to appear before it. He will be taken for further investigation to Hassan district where a sexual harassment case against him was registered after a woman lodged a complaint in April. Gowda has been charged under sections 354 (A), 354C, 448, 504, 506, and 34 of the IPC and 66(E) of the

Information Technology Act, 2008. Earlier on May 6, Gowda had publicly denounced the ruling Congress government in Karnataka, condemning it for "trying to frame the BJP and Prime Minister Narendra Modi" in Prajwal Revanna case. The grand old party, however, rebuffed all accusations made by Gowda calling it a "bundle of lies". Gowda also alleged that the Karnataka government was making attempts to stifle the

proofs and distort the investigation, terming the SIT as "remote-controlled" by the state government. **Blue Corner notice issued against Prajwal Revanna** Earlier, Karnataka Home Minister, G Parameshwara said that a Blue Corner notice was issued against Prajwal Revanna. A blue notice permits Interpol to gather details regarding an individual's identity, whereabouts, or actions linked to a criminal inquiry. Parameshwara also said that the state government is requesting Interpol's help in repatriating Prajwal Revanna, accused of serious sexual harassment. Earlier, Janata Dal (Secular) party leader HD Revanna was arrested in the matter and brought to the SIT office. The action was taken by the police on the basis of a complaint filed by the son of the woman who was allegedly "abducted and sexually abused". The FIR alleged that the woman who worked as a housemaid at HD Revanna's home for six years was sexually abused by Revanna's son Prajwal, who is also the Lok Sabha candidate for BJP-JD(S) from the Hassan constituency, before returning to her village.

PM Modi tells Sharad Pawar and Uddhav Thackeray to join BJP-led NDA, NCP (SP) leader responds



The International Press : Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Friday (May 10) took a swipe at Uddhav Thackeray and Sharad Pawar advising the NCP (SP) leader and Shiv Sena (UBT) chief to join hands with Ajit Pawar and Eknath Shinde after the results of Lok Sabha polls are released instead of "dying by merging" with the Congress. "A big leader here who is active for 40-50 years is worried after polling in Baramati (Lok Sabha seat). He says that after June 4, smaller parties, in order to

survive, will merge with the Congress," PM Modi said in an apparent reference to Pawar without taking his name. "This means the nakli NCP and nakli Shiv Sena have made up their minds to merge with the Congress," PM Modi said, addressing an election rally in Nandurbar district of north Maharashtra. "But instead of dying by merging with the Congress, come to Ajit Pawar and Eknath Shinde," the prime minister exclaimed.

Pawar reacts Pawar, reacting to PM Modi's comments said that he will not partner with any person, party or ideology that does not back parliamentary democracy. "PM Modi's recent speeches have been conducive to creating rifts among communities, which is dangerous for the country. Wherever things are not in the nation's interest, neither I nor my colleagues will venture," he said. PM Modi's remarks came after the NCP (SP) leader in a recent statement said that factions and regional parties should either come closer or merge with the Congress in the coming years. "In the next couple of years, several regional parties will associate more closely with the Congress. Or they may look at the option of merging with the Congress if they believe that is the best for their party." NCP (SP) chief

why he should not resign after such allegations were levelled against him," she said. Yadav calls for Muslim reservation, stirs political row Shah's comments came after Rashtriya Janata Dal (RJD) supremo Lalu Prasad Yadav stirred a political row with his remarks about giving complete reservation to Muslims.

"In 2019, the public of Telangana gave us four seats. This time, we will win more than 10 Lok Sabha seats in Telangana. This double-digit score in Telangana will make PM Modi cross 400 seats... Make BJP victorious on more than 10 seats. We will end the Muslim reservation and increase the reservation of SC, ST, and OBC," he added.

Calling for a Muslim quota, the former Bihar chief minister said, "Muslims should get a complete reservation." Prime Minister Narendra Modi, slammed the RJD chief over his remarks and accused the INDI Alliance of slashing the reservation rights of ST, SC and OBC communities. PM Modi then took a jibe at Lalu stating that the "fodder scam accused" leader who at present is out on bail, is advocating for the reservation rights of the Muslim population.

Haiti to rotate transitional council leader



The International Press : Haiti's transitional ruling council which is leading the violence-racked Caribbean nation will rotate its leadership every five months according to a decree seen by AFP Friday, following internal political strife among its members. The new council came to power last month as Haiti's unpopular and unelected prime minister Ariel Henry submitted his formal resignation after armed gangs rose up and demanded his ouster. Several days after the council's nine members were sworn in, they chose politician Edgard Leblanc Fils from among themselves to head the long-awaited governing body.

said, the body had "proceeded by consensus to a rotating presidency." It also agreed that its most important decisions, including appointment of a prime minister and a government, would be made by a majority of five votes out of seven. Leblanc Fils will be leader of the council until October 7, to be followed sequentially by members Smith Augustin, Leslie Voltaire and Louis Gerald Gilles. "Cohesion within the transitional presidential council is an overriding necessity to guarantee a solution to the

multidimensional crisis facing the Haitian nation," the decree read. Haiti, a nation of 11.6 million people, has suffered from poverty, political instability and natural disasters for decades. It is the poorest country in the Americas. Its situation plummeted starting in late February as powerful and well-armed gangs that control most of the capital Port-au-Prince and much of the country went on a rampage they said was aimed at toppling prime minister Henry. In recent days, the United States has flown 21 sorties into Port-au-Prince, delivering cargo and civilian contractors, according to information published by the US Southern Command on Friday. The objective is to help prepare Haiti for deployment of a UN-backed multinational force -- to be led by Kenya -- which is tasked with helping its beleaguered police rein in the criminal gangs.
