

India Election: Dance videos of Modi, rival turn up AI heat



The International Press : An AI video shows an ecstatic Narendra Modi sporting a trendy jacket and trousers, grooving on a stage to a Bollywood song as the crowd cheers. The Indian prime minister reshared the video on X, saying "such creativity in peak poll season is truly a delight." Another video, with the same stage setting, shows Modi's rival Mamata Banerjee dancing in a saree-like outfit, but the background score is parts of her speech criticizing those who quit her party to join Modi's. The different reactions to videos created using artificial intelligence (AI) tools underscore how the use and abuse of the technology is increasing and creating worries for regulators and security officials as the world's most populous nation holds a mammoth general election. India's Election Commission last week warned political parties against AI use to spread misinformation and shared seven provisions of information technology and other laws that attract jail terms of up to three years for offences including forgery, promoting rumours and

accepted her. She further asserted during her very first public address amid the ongoing Lok Sabha election campaign that Rahul "won't disappoint them". Recalling the 'age-old' roots of the Gandhi family with the people of the constituency, the AICC chief expressed gratitude to the residents of the city.

"I am very happy that I got the opportunity to come among you after so long... You all gave me the opportunity to serve you as an MP, this is the biggest treasure of my life. For the last 100 years, the roots of our family are connected to the soil of this land. This relation is as pure as Ganga Maa. It started with the farmer's agitation of Awadh and Raebareli," Sonia Gandhi said addressing the public meeting. 'There was special place for Raebareli in Indira Ji's heart'

She then said that she had imparted the same teachings to both her children, Rahul as well as Priyanka, that she had learnt from the people of the constituency while serving as the MP and also from former Prime Minister Indira Gandhi. "In Indira Ji's heart, there was a special place for Raebareli. I have seen her

working very closely, she had immense affection for you all. I have given the same teachings to Rahul and Priyanka, that Indira Ji and the people of Raebareli had bestowed upon me; Respect all, protect the weak, fight for people's rights against injustice, don't be sacred, because the roots of struggle is very strong," Sonia said. "My aanchal (end of a saari, also refers to protective shelter) was always filled with your love and affection. Your love never made me feel alone Everything I have is yours...I am handing over my son to you. You have to accept him and keep him, just like you accepted me. Rahul will not disappoint you," the Congress leader said.

Congress leader Rahul Gandhi is set to contest the general elections from Raebareli, which is the erstwhile constituency of her mother. Sonia, since the year 2004, held the constituency for four consecutive terms before she decided to take over as the Rajya Sabha MP earlier this year. The grand old party lost its other bastion Amethi to BJP in the year 2019. BJP has nominated incumbent MP and Union Minister Smriti Irani to contest the seat in the current elections, whereas the Congress has fielded its long-time loyalist Kishori Lal Sharma. Polling on both the seats will be held on May 20, which is the fifth phase of the ongoing elections.

Manoj Bajpayee recalls RACIST encounters, being called a pornstar: Here's what happened

The International Press : Known for his brilliant acting prowess, Indian star Manoj Bajpayee is not a slave to an introduction. The actor, who has delivered several hit shows and series, has now spoken up about struggling in the initial days of his career. While Manoj has become famous worldwide, there were times when he was racially profiled as well. Manoj Bajpayee recalls RACIST encounters, being called a pornstar: Here's what happened. The actor's role as a prince in Zubeida was acclaimed globally but Manoj recalls how many critics had opined that he doesn't 'look' like a prince. "Some critics wrote 'He's good but he doesn't fit the role, he's good but he doesn't look like a prince.' I thought these people

are so liberal and evolved that they do not realise they are such big racists," Manoj commented. Manoj Bajpayee recalls RACIST encounters, being called a pornstar: Here's what happened. "They were too racist. Then I showed it to a few of my friends. I said, 'How should I take it?' They said 'Spit it off, this is biased and in its core it is a racist thing.' But today when I was doing interviews for Bhaiyya Ji, four out of five journalists were talking about my performance in Zubeida," he added. He further remarked, "I personally don't answer the criticism at all. Yes, sometimes I do quote fake news reports and ask 'when did I say this.' But if you will talk about my bad performance and my looks, I will not retort back. I will let it go,

because the answer lies in the future which can only come through my work. I have many cuttings (newspaper reviews) where people have been very brutal, lethal and racist." Manoj Bajpayee recalls RACIST encounters, being called a pornstar: Here's what happened. Manoj continued, "I did a film called Fareh, it wasn't well made and it failed, it happens sometimes. Somebody wrote, 'Now Bhikhu Matre of Satya has become a porn star.' That hurt me, it really offended me. No reviewer has the right to go that dirty. You can talk about my film, how it is made. How does that make me a porn star? There is nothing I did in that film to suggest that. Now my filmography is there for everyone to see. You will get your answers there."

"Manthan", centered on the groundbreaking milk cooperative movement led by Dr Verghese Kurien—the architect of India's White Revolution—was produced by five lakh dairy farmers of the Gujarat Cooperative Milk Marketing Federation (GCMMF), which also markets the film. The film featuring Naseeruddin Shah and the late actress Smita Patil is the sole Indian film selected for the Cannes Classic section at this year's festival. "Manthan" is part of the Cannes

lineup with Payal Kapadia's "All We Imagine As Light" (selected for the Competition section), Maimon Ali's "In Retreat" (showing in the sidebar ACID Cannes programme), and Chidanand S Naik's "Sunflowers Were The First Ones To Know" (chosen for the competitive La Cinef category). Additionally, British filmmaker Sandhya Suri's "Santosh", starring Indian actor Shahana Goswami, will also be showcased at Cannes. The Cannes film premiere will be attended by Naseeruddin Shah, the family of the late Smita Patil, the film's producers, and Shivendra Singh Dungarpur from the Film Heritage Foundation. Co-written by Benegal and renowned playwright Vijay Tendulkar, "Manthan" is set in Gujarat and is believed to be India's first crowd-funded film. The movie was entirely financed by 500,000 farmers who each donated Rs.2. In 1977, "Manthan" received two National Film Awards: Best Feature Film in Hindi and Best Screenplay for Tendulkar. It was also India's official submission to the 1976 Academy Awards in the Best Foreign Language Film category.

Mbappe bids farewell to PSG fans with defeat in final home game



The International Press : Kylian Mbappe scored on his final home appearance as a Paris Saint-Germain player on Sunday but the French champions suffered a surprise 3-1 defeat against Toulouse on the night they picked up the Ligue 1 championship trophy. Mbappe confirmed in a video posted on social media on Friday that he would be leaving PSG when his contract expires at the end of the season, ending a seven-year association with the club. Real Madrid is expected to be the next destination for a player whose departure from Paris had been an open secret since February, when he privately informed the club of his intention to move on. Mbappe wore the captain's armband and opened the scoring early on against

Toulouse to take his tally for the season to 44 goals goals in all competitions. However, Thijs Dallinga quickly equalised for the visitors against a PSG side which showed 10 changes to the team knocked out of the Champions League by Borussia Dortmund in the semi-finals in midweek, with Mbappe the only player to keep his place. Yann Gboho put Toulouse ahead with a brilliant strike in the second half, and Frank Magri wrapped up the win in stoppage time as PSG suffered just their second Ligue 1 loss this season, and their first in 27 games since September. Mbappe has now scored 256 times for PSG, a club-record tally, since signing from Monaco in 2017 in a deal worth 180 million euros (\$194 million).

His tally of 191 goals in France's top flight -- including 16 with Monaco at the beginning of his career -- puts him in seventh place in the all-time list. Coach Luis Enrique described the 25-year-old as "a club legend" when he spoke to media on the eve of the game. PSG had indicated that celebrations after Sunday's match would be dedicated to their title triumph, rather than any specific tribute to Mbappe himself. There were even some jeers from the crowd for the striker when the teams were read out before the game, although a huge display was unfurled before kick-off at one end of the stadium depicting Mbappe in a trademark pose with his arms folded. "I heard applause, the supporters paid him a

deserved tribute, he is a club legend despite his youth," said Luis Enrique who described the banner as "beautiful". The Qatar-owned club had already wrapped up a record-extending 12th French title, and 10th in 12 years, before hosting a Toulouse side who were themselves safe from any lingering threat of relegation. PSG's Champions League disappointment means Mbappe will leave the club without ever having got his hands on European football's greatest prize. With Mbappe, PSG were runners-up in 2020 and have since reached the last four on two further occasions, but the France captain will now hope to finally get his hands on the trophy at his next club. PSG can still finish the

season by completing a clean sweep of domestic honours, as they face Lyon in the French Cup final in Lyon on May 25. As well as Ligue 1, they have also already won the Champions Trophy, France's equivalent of a Super Cup. Monaco into Champions League Luis Enrique's team will complete their league campaign with a visit to Nice on Wednesday before going to Metz in their final game next Sunday. Elsewhere, Mbappe's first club Monaco clinched second place and automatic qualification for next season's Champions League with a 2-0 win away at Montpellier. Lille moved up into third place above Brest on goal difference as Jonathan David netted twice in their 2-1 win at Nantes. The top three in Ligue 1 qualify directly for next season's expanded, 36-team Champions League with the team finishing fourth entering the competition in the preliminary rounds. Nice are fifth and trail both Lille and Brest by four points but still have a chance of a top-four place before hosting PSG in midweek. Lens drew 1-1 at Rennes to hold onto sixth, while Orel Mangala's goal gave Lyon a 1-0 win at Clermont as they kept their European hopes alive. Pierre-Emerick Aubameyang scored twice as Marseille beat Lorient 3-1 to also remain in the European picture. At the bottom, Clermont's defeat means they are relegated, while Lorient are almost certainly down too as they trail Metz by three points with one game left and have an inferior goal difference. Metz, who lost 2-1 at Strasbourg, are therefore set to go into a play-off against a team from Ligue 2 with a top-flight place for next season on the line.

Babar Azam becomes most successful T20I captain



The International Press : Pakistan skipper Babar Azam went to the top of an illustrious list on Sunday when his side claimed a seven-wicket triumph over Ireland in the second T20I in Dublin. Babar's side successfully chased down Ireland's decent total of 193-7 with more than three overs remaining courtesy of a 140-run partnership between Mohammad Rizwan (75*) and Fakhar Zaman (78) and it proved the record-breaking 45th T20I victory for Pakistan's influential captain. It took Babar past Uganda's Brian Masaba for the most wins by male T20I captains and in front of former skipper in the ilk of England's Eoin Morgan, India's MS Dhoni and Australia's Aaron Finch. Fakhar displayed his power-hitting prowess as he smashed six sixes and a steadier Rizwan played the support role with aplomb as the pair put on 140 in quick time to take the game away from Ireland. While Fakhar was dismissed in the 15th over to provide the hosts with a glimmer of hope, Azam Khan joined the party to hit an unbeaten 30 from just 10 deliveries to guide Pakistan home.

Hungry Madrid parade league title with eye on European glory



The International Press : If anything defines Real Madrid it is a relentless hunger for silverware and that remained clear even as they celebrated their 36th La Liga title triumph on Sunday. Los Blancos players partied with fans at their traditional location outside the city's Cibeles palace but the upcoming Champions League final remained in focus. The record 14-time European champions face Borussia Dortmund at Wembley on June 1 and various players said they hoped they could return to celebrate again after the final. "Thank you for being here to celebrate this day... I hope we see each other again in June," said veteran midfielder Luka Modric, a five-time Champions League winner with Real. Madrid sealed their triumph last weekend with four games to spare, taking the title back from rivals Barcelona, but delayed the celebration to concentrate on beating Bayern Munich in midweek to reach the Champions League final. Dominant Madrid have lost just one match this season in La Liga, against rivals Atletico Madrid last September, and at present have scored more goals and conceded fewer than any other side in the division. They won both Clasicos against Barcelona and twice defeated their closest challengers for much of the season, Catalan upstarts Girona. Coach Carlo Ancelotti was a central figure in the celebrations, once again toting a cigar and wearing sunglasses as he did at Madrid's last parade in 2022. The day began early with RFEF president Pedro Rocha delivering the league trophy to Madrid's Valdebebas training ground at 0730 GMT, with captain Nacho Fernandez lifting it, for the first but certainly not the last occasion on the day. "Today is the day to enjoy it, when it's something so deserved, something so big as winning the league, it's the day to go to Cibeles," said Nacho. There were other stops on the way for Madrid's jubilant players, first heading to the Madrid regional government's headquarters, presenting the trophy to president Isabel Diaz Ayuso. "This team has overcome a lot of adversity, with a lot of injuries," said Madrid chief Florentino Perez, referring to Thibaut Courtois, Eder Militao and David Alaba's long-term absences in particular. "This squad rebelled against the situation, this club badge achieves everything that seems impossible -- the attitude (you need) in the face of life. "I want to thank all of the players that now form part of the history of the club -- they have won it all and are still hungry." Of course, Perez was keen to highlight the team's next target. "We will leave our soul out there to come back with the 15th," he added.

Arsenal grind out Man Utd win to go top of the Premier League



The International Press : Arsenal kept their Premier League title dreams alive by ending an Old Trafford hoodoo to grind out a 1-0 win at Manchester United on Sunday to move back top of the table. Leandro Trossard scored the only goal on 20 minutes as Arsenal won for just the second time in 17 games away at United to go a point clear at the summit. Manchester City still have the destiny of the title in their own hands as the defending champions have two matches left to Arsenal's one. However, the Gunners kept the pressure on Pep Guardiola's men ahead of their tricky trip to Tottenham on Tuesday. Defeat further dented United's chances of competing in Europe next season. Erik ten Hag's men showed more spirit than in a dismal 4-0 defeat to Crystal Palace on Monday, but have now won just one of their last eight Premier League games. United remain eighth in the table, three points adrift of both Newcastle, who they face on Wednesday, and Chelsea. Arsenal have been in scintillating form in 2024 to remain in the race for their first league title in 20 years. Mikel Arteta's men have won 15 and drawn one of their 17

league games since the turn of the year. But Arsenal were far from their flowing best as the expected onslaught of an injury-ravaged United never materialised under unusually stifling heat in England's north-west. The manner of defeat at Palace had increased the scrutiny on United boss Ten Hag. He made three changes to the team swept aside at Selhurst Park as Scott McTominay, Sofyan Amrabat and Amad Diallo came in. The Dutchman's options were again hamstrung by a lengthy list of absentees with captain Bruno Fernandes among those sidelined and a bench littered with youngsters. But his decision to retain Casemiro as a makeshift centre-back after his woeful showing against Palace will become another stick to beat the beleaguered coach with. The Brazil captain was dropped from their squad for the Copa America in midweek due to his terrible form. After United had managed to keep the free-scoring visitors at bay for the opening 20 minutes, Casemiro was culpable for the opening goal. The 32-year-old was laboured in pushing up from a United goal-kick to play Kai Havertz inside and Trossard then stole in on the blind side of

Casemiro to tap in the German's cross. United's new co-owner Jim Ratcliffe was in attendance at Old Trafford rather than at Wembley to see the club's women pick up their first ever major trophy in the FA Cup final. The work that lies ahead of Ratcliffe has been laid bare in recent weeks, but the home side did manage to keep the majority of the 74,000 crowd onside by taking the game to Arsenal after the break. Arsenal, though, were rarely seriously troubled as they held out for a sixth clean sheet in their last seven away league games. Alejandro Garnacho was United's one live wire but smashed into the side-netting with his best chance to equalise. Gabriel Martinelli and Declan Rice were denied by brilliant Andre Onana saves to prevent Arsenal the second goal they craved to avoid a tense finale. The visitors desperation to see the game out was evident as Martinelli took the ball to the corner with 10 minutes of the 90 still to play. But Arsenal did just enough to ask the question City, who host West Ham on the final day of the season after their visit to north London in midweek.

Brilliant Leverkusen stretch unbeaten run to 50



The International Press : Bayer Leverkusen stretched their season-long unbeaten run to 50 games with a 5-0 win at 10-man Bochum on Sunday. Bochum defeated a 10-man Leverkusen in May 2023, the last time to beat Xabi Alonso's side in any competition, but the tables turned on Sunday with Leverkusen's goals coming from five different scorers. Alonso's league champions are just one game away from the first unbeaten Bundesliga season and three games from a remarkable treble. Leverkusen midfielder Robert Andrich told DAZN he had his sights set on a "unique" triple. "We couldn't have imagined how much the Bundesliga title meant to the club and the fans. "Next week we'll hold the trophy high in our own stadium, which will be emotional and beautiful. After that we're off to Dublin and Berlin and we want to grab both titles and go on holiday with the triple in our backpacks." Within three days in late May, Leverkusen face Atalanta in the Europa League final in Dublin before taking on second-division Kaiserslautern

in the German Cup final. Bochum lost a man early when Felix Passlack saw red for a last-man foul on Nathan Tella. With attacking midfield maestro Florian Wirtz missing through injury, Alonso started strikers Victor Boniface and Patrik Schick and both had a goal by half-time. Schick blasted in an Arthur cross with a superb first-touch finish after 41 minutes. Boniface converted a penalty five minutes later after Tella was fouled in the box. Amine Adli, brought on for Schick with 20 minutes remaining, headed in a corner to make it 3-0. Josip Stanisic, who scored in stoppage time to keep Leverkusen's unbeaten run alive against Roma in the Europa League on Thursday, added a fourth with three minutes remaining before setting up Alex Grimaldo's goal in the final moments. **No Kane, no problem for Bayern** Thomas Tuchel's heavily changed Bayern Munich line-up made short work of Wolfsburg at home, winning 2-0 to leapfrog Stuttgart into second spot. Tuchel made eight changes to

the side eliminated from the Champions League with a 2-1 loss at Real Madrid on Wednesday, with England captain Harry Kane, out with back issues, missing his first league match of the season. If the England captain returns next week, Kane -- currently on 36 league goals this season -- will have just one match remaining to try and reach Robert Lewandowski's all-time record of 41. Bayern captain Manuel Neuer was proud with his side for bouncing back after the disappointing and controversial loss to Real. "We were in control for over 90 minutes and got into the game well, that was crucial," Neuer told DAZN. "Real was difficult to deal with, today we had to ignore it - we did a good job of that." The win sends Bayern two points clear of Stuttgart in second with one game remaining. Croatian midfielder Lovro Zvonarek, aged just 19, celebrated his first start by scoring after four minutes. Leon Goretzka was set up by Thomas Mueller just 10 minutes later. Four minutes after Goretzka's goal, Spain winger Bryan

Zaragoza, also making his first league start for Bayern, had a goal was ruled out for offside. Bayern, who will finish the season without a trophy for the first time since 2012, gradually took the sting out of the match and handed out further debuts in the final stages. Israel goalkeeper Daniel Peretz came on late in the second half, replacing Bayern captain Manuel Neuer who was playing his 500th Bundesliga game. Teenagers Matteo Perez Vinolo and Jonathan Asp-Jensen also came on. "Daniel has given the team so much and shown good performances, he simply deserves to get minutes," said Neuer. The loss means Wolfsburg are yet to win in the Bavarian capital after 27 games. Earlier on Sunday, Hoffenheim boosted their chances of qualifying for Europe with a 6-0 demolition of already relegated Darmstadt. Both Ihlas Bebou and Maximilian Beier scored doubles with Pavel Kaderabek and former Liverpool centre-back Ozan Kabak adding goals against the last-placed team.
